

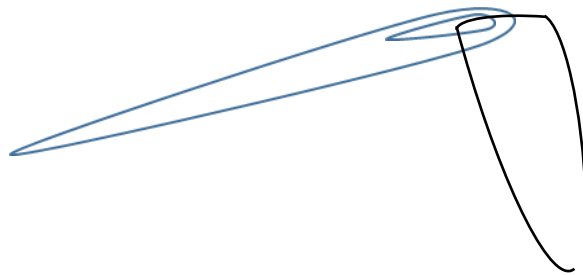
REMEMBRANCE POPPY



An easy activity which can be used to make individual poppies or gather them together to make a group wreath

Step One

Pull the thread through the eye of the needle, creating a loop. Tie the two ends together with a double, or large knot.



Step Two

Take your circular piece of material and sew a running stitch about 1cm in from the edge. Continue stitching all the way around the circle, keeping the stitches evenly spaced and not too small.

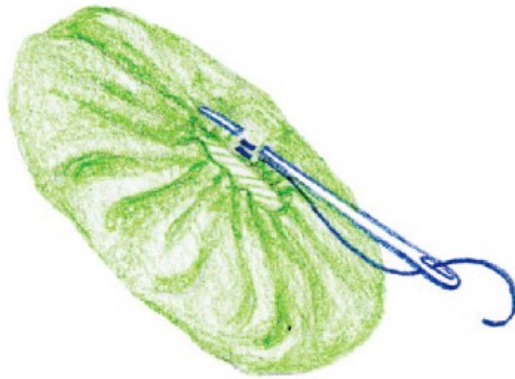


Step Three

Once you reach the start point, pull the needle through and start to pull the stitches together. Hold down the material in the middle and pull out the edges slightly to form folds.

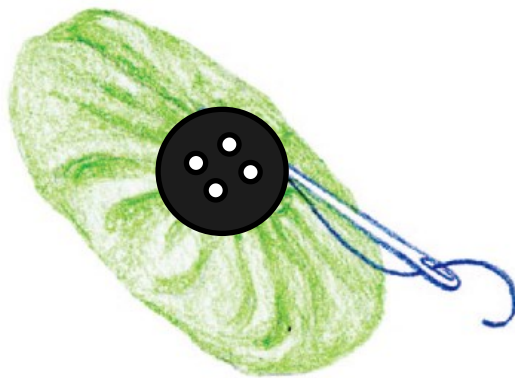
Step Four

Secure the gathered material in the middle with a couple of stitches through the puff.



Step Five

Place a button on top of the gathered material and sew in place.



Step Six

Secure the thread with a couple of small stitches at the back of the puff. Cut the thread.
